<u>http://www.blueletterbible.org/index.html</u> This is a searchable concordance with commentary, Hebrew/Greek dictionaries, hymns and other tools attached. It's really quite extraordinary.

<u>http://www.biblegateway.com/</u> This is an online concordance. You can search for both words and passages in a variety of Bible translations.

<u>www.biblestudytools.net/</u> This is your one-stop shop for personal bible study. It has everything from concordance tools, commentaries, sermon helps, to a nifty parallel tool for looking at different translations of a single verse. It does not have the NIV or its tools, however. Furthermore, its Greek and Hebrew stuff is all transliterated.

<u>www.carm.org/dresources.htm</u> This site contains an incredible array of links from apologetics to politics, from cults to theology.

<u>www.ccel.org</u> This is an *unbelievable* array of classics online. We're talking full text, everything from Augustine to Wesley. This will save you hundreds of dollars and a lot of shelf space.
